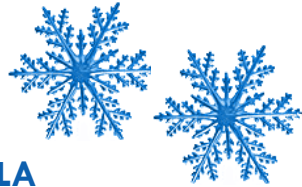

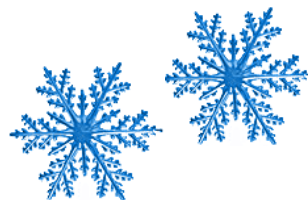
TL Certification Scholarship
