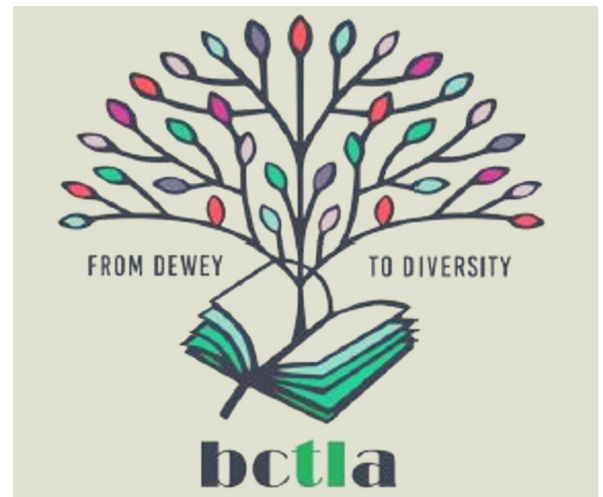
BCTLA CONFERENCE
